



## RACE TO THE LINE IS NOW ACCREDITED BY THE BRITISH SCIENCE ASSOCIATION FOR CREST AWARDS



We are delighted to announce that Race To The Line [www.racetotheline.co.uk](http://www.racetotheline.co.uk) has been accredited by the British Science Association at both CREST Discovery Award and CREST Bronze Award Levels.

All students engaged in designing and racing a car at a school race day can apply for a CREST Discovery Award. <https://www.crestawards.org/crest-discovery> Students that progress in the competition and that make and improve cars to compete at regional or national stages, can apply for a CREST Bronze Award. <https://www.crestawards.org/crest-bronze>

Students taking part in Race To The Line engage in a wide range of science and engineering activities to design, test and improve the performance of their rocket cars.

CREST awards are highly respected and can be used by students to enhance their UCAS personal statements.

### **NEXT STEPS FOR A SCHOOL:**

CREST Discovery and Bronze Awards are assessed by a teacher or group leader, usually at the end of the activity. Students applying for a Discovery Award need to complete around 5 hours of STEM activity. Students applying for a CREST Bronze Award need to complete around 10 hours of work.

They record and reflect on their work during the project, using the online platform.

For a fee of £3 (free in Wales) for Discovery Level and for £5 (free in Wales) for Bronze Level, students can receive a personalised certificate from the British Science Association.
